

CONTRIBUTION DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- Ayurved Mahavidyalaya and Hospital has worked as CCC (Covid Care Centre) from April 2020 as per the order of Zila Parishad Pune and worked as DCHC (Dedicated Covid Health Centre) since July 2020. Till Date the number of Covid-19 Positive Patient treated are 485.
- 2. Currently we are running a special Ayurvedic OPD for Post Covid-19 conditions.
- 3. Our staff has completed various training programmes as per the guidelines from Ministry of AYUSH, CCIM, MCIM, Directorate of AYUSH and MUHS.
- 4. Training programmes from WHO, IGOT etc. are also completed by our staff.
- 5. Hospital staff, PG students are working in CCC centre and following the protocol as per the guidelines of the Government time to time.
- 6. Teaching staff is taking on line lectures of UG and PG students.
- 7. Awareness lectures to the staff about the Covid-19 were taken by our doctors.
- 8. An Immunity booster in the form of *Ayurvedic Herbs Kadh*a (Decoction) is prepared daily in college and Hospital and distributed to all staff till date.
- 9. Students actively participate in NSS activities guided by M.U.H.S. like preparation of mask, prepared awareness Videos regarding Covid-19 prevention.
- 10. As a preventive measure Dhoopa and Arka were prepared as described in *Sushrut Samhita*.
- 11. Daily protocols as per the govt .norms to prevent Covid-19 infection are followed by all the staff members.
- 12. Daily sanitization and distribution of Kadha is practised to take care of all the staff members.
- 13. At present the Ayurved Mahavidyalaya and Hospital is working as DCHC since June 2020.
- 14. At present Ayurved Mahavidyalaya and Hospital is working as a centre for Covishield Vaccination.
